REQUIREMENTS TO PADDLE:

To make Marlow Witches Regatta as fun and stress-free as possible, please note the following instructions:

1. Please provide your own kayak or canoe. Paddleboards and pets are NOT allowed.
2. Life vests are required to be in the boat. All children are invited to join the regatta, but those 12 and under must be in a vessel with an adult and wear a life vest as required by New Hampshire Fish and Game.
3. Please try to arrive by 10:15. Parking and launching assistance will be available. We will be on the water from 11am to noon.
4. This is a VERY VISUAL event that calls for a black witch’s hat, plain or decorate any way you want. Remember to secure your hat so you don’t lose it on the water!
5. Please try to send in your donation and form PRIOR to the event. We are expecting more witches this year and that will make it easier for both witches and volunteers!

DIRECTIONS FOR LAUNCH SITE:

Coming from Keene, 1st dirt driveway on the right after downtown Marlow bridge and pond. There will be a witches sign there. You can unload there and then park at the “Witches Parking” signs.

Parking: Either park head-in at the “Witches Parking” signs and walk kayak down the driveway then follow the sign to the left, or park at the larger witch parking lot just ahead – look for signs. There will be someone to help you unload your kayak at the launching site if needed and will assist witches to get launched into Village Pond and disembarked at noon.
